ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT THINGS ABOUT YOUR STUDENTS' UNION IS THAT IT'S RUN BY STUDENTS, FOR STUDENTS.

We support you to make your time at university count, by making student life easier for you.

The best way for us to find out how to do this is to give you the chance to tell us what you love, what needs to change (on your course, where you live and even nationally) and what you need help with.

As there are a lot of you, we ask you to elect a team of presidents that you want to represent your views. We elect lots of part-time representatives who ultimately feed into your president team.

If you are wondering how it all works, here are the main stages of the elections process (dates TBC):

NOMINATIONS (OR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST) OPEN

This is where anyone who is considering running for a position fills in a short online form at hullunion.com/nominatenow to express their interest.

NOMINATIONS CLOSE

The deadline by which all nominations must be submitted.

TRAINING AND SUPPORT

You will be given plenty of information, training and support to help you understand more about the roles available, how to write a clear manifesto based on student needs, and how to plan your campaign to encourage others to vote for you.

QUESTION TIME

A key event in the elections calendar! Answer students' questions on the issues that matter most to them so they can decide who to vote for.

VOTING

All voting takes place online at hullunion.com/votetnow.

RESULTS

Announcement of who has been elected into the different positions.

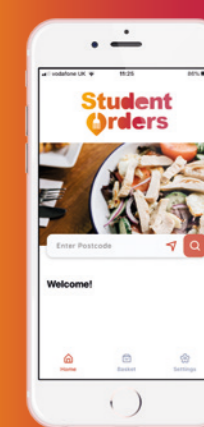
